May Tax Revenues $\$ 271.3$ million below Monthly Estimate
Office of Budget and Management Releases Preliminary May Revenue Data
The Office of Budget and Management released preliminary May 2020 revenue data. Total General Revenue Fund tax receipts finished the month $\$ 271.3$ million (-13.0\%) below estimate.

Total fiscal-year-to-date tax receipts through May are below estimate by $\$ 1.05$ billion $(-4.9 \%)$ and are $\$ 877.7$ million ( $-4.1 \%$ ) below total tax receipts through the same period last fiscal year.

Displayed below is each recent month's percentage variation (not year-to-date variations) from estimate for the three tax sources most impacted during the pandemic.

May total sales and use tax revenues missed estimates by 17.6 percent ( $\$ 167.3$ million, split between non-auto sales and use taxes which were $\$ 133.4$ million below estimate and auto sales and use taxes which were $\$ 33.8$ million below estimate). Through May, fiscal year-to-date sales and use tax revenues are below estimate by $\$ 326.6$ million ( $-3.3 \%$ ).

May income tax revenues missed estimate by 15.1 percent ( $\$ 91.4$ million). Fiscal year-todate income tax receipts are below estimate by $\$ 767.0$ million ( $-9.7 \%$ ).
"The global COVID-19 pandemic continues to impact Ohio's communities - our fellow Ohioans, our families and neighbors - in numerous ways. GRF tax receipts have not met projections for the third month; however, we are beginning to see initial signs of recovery as the shortfalls in May were not as dramatic as in April," said Kimberly Murnieks, OBM Director.
